Benefits of Participating in ReelEducation ReelAbilities: Houston Film & Arts Festival 2019

- 1) Exposes students to the lives, stories, and talents of people with disabilities.
- 2) Gives students the opportunity to think about their own perceptions and attitudes towards individuals with disabilities.
- 3) Students learn about what it means to be inclusive of those with disabilities.
- 4) Post-screening discussions will allow students to interact with the filmmaker, protagonist, educators, or individuals with disabilities and have an open dialogue about topics addressed in the film(s).
- 5) Program allows further reflection of how individual classes and an entire school can become more inclusive communities.



How it Works

- 1) Educators review pre-selected films online and select films that they want to share with their school/grade/classroom (provided by ReelAbilities).
- 2) Educators select dates and times (see available schedule of showings) for program. Programs can be on-site at school or off-site at theater.
- 3) If schools are unable to attend off-site screenings due to transportation costs, please contact ReelAbilities@jfshouston.org to inquire if funding is available.
- 4) Post-screening discussion facilitators provided by ReelAbilities.
